<p>I. Consent Agenda</p> <p>a. February CAP Meeting Minutes</p> <p>b. 2022 Quality Incentive Measure (QIM) Performance</p>	<p>On a motion duly made by Dr. James Strohschein and seconded by Susan Lowe, the CAP unanimously approved the Consent Agenda.</p>
<p>II. CGHC Board Agenda Review</p>	<p>The Board approved the new CAP members, Shannon O’Brien, Dr. James Strohschein, and Jaime Preston.</p> <p>The Board approved the CAP’s recommendation to allocate \$1.2 Million of the 2021 shared savings to Primary Care organizations based on CCO member assignments. Organizations will sign a letter of agreement that lists examples of ways to use the funds for improving access to care and submit a report of how funds were used at the end of the year.</p> <p>The Board also agreed with the recommendation to reserve \$300K of the 2021 shared savings to invest in behavioral and oral health care access. The Board will wait to see what the CAP and CAP workgroups recommend before making a decision.</p> <p>Amy Scholze gave a demo of the new Community Health Assessment (CHA)/Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) platform. The website provides data that will aid in making data driven funding decision and support community wide collaboration on the CHA and CHIP.</p>
<p>III. CAC Agenda and Report</p>	<p>Overview and discussion of upcoming redeterminations. Presentation on the health equity plan. Update and planning for the upcoming CHA cycle.</p>
<p>IV. Activity</p>	<p>The CAP participated in a team-building activity.</p>
<p>V. CAP evaluation feedback & plan next steps</p>	<p>Jenny shared the CAP’s feedback on the evaluation plan. Some key points were included: the CAP would like project funding to be announced and</p>

	available to the whole community for applying. The CAP also think the workgroups needed more support from the Health Council.
VI. Funding streams overview	<p>Jenny provided an overview of CGHC funding streams that would be coming to the CAP later in the year. The CAP may have close to \$1M available for projects and workgroups later in the year.</p> <p>The group discussed options for allocating the funds. Suggestions included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working with the workgroups to come up with proposals • Sending out a request for proposals in the community • Reserving some funds to use later in case future funding is limited <p>The CAP would like a chance to hear more about the workgroups, their work, and needs at the next meeting to help guide the process.</p>
