The recommendation was made to the CAC to consider carefully the aim of investments and work within Indian country, and offered to do regular work sessions with the CAC in the coming year. Buffy was asked to review several of the grant proposals that primarily addressed working with American Indian/Alaskan Native populations in the service
