Approve October CAC meeting minutes	On a motion approved and seconded, the October CAC minute meetings were unanimously approved.
Recent CGHC Board Meeting topics	Ellen gave an update from the previous Board meeting. Elke Towey, PacificSource's Practice Facilitator for the CCO, is available meet with those interested in follow-up on the Quality Incentive Measures (QIM). It was discussed that Elke could come and discuss QIM's throughout the next few CAC meetings. In particular, the group is interested in those with disparities between Medicaid and privately insured
Community Grant Applications • Review results of application scoring	Coco shared that the meeting goal would be to make a final recommendation to the Board on Community Grant Applications. Any proposal over \$50,000 will be reviewed by the Clinical Advisory Panel (CAP) as well.
Finalize decisions	Coco reviewed the process for how the voting committee results were tallied and a graph was shown which highlighted each proposal's committee score on a grid using both Overall Support and Total Score results. At this stage, the names of the proposals were not known.
	Coco shared that all but three of the proposals sat in the positive area but three of the proposals had a Median score of neutral. After a robust discussion, there was a motion made and seconded to drop the three proposals for consideration. The CAC unanimously approved the removal of the 3 proposals for funding consideration with one abstention by Debby Jones because she had not been part of the voting process.
	The remainder of the time was spent reviewing and discussing the 8 remaining proposals in order based on Overall Support and then Total Score. After a brief review, the CAC discussed a range of options for possibly adjusting the order based on the dialog. After an exhaustive discussion by the CAC, the final conclusion by the

CAC was that the voting process used was thorough and no adjustments would be made to the order other than displaying the 2 proposals with the exact same scores side-by-side. Coco will follow-up with Consumer members to gather any additional comments they may want included for the final Board recommendation. Future meeting topic ❖ It was suggested that at a future meeting, someone from transportation come speak about the future of Mid-Columbia Council of Governments' (MCCOG) work.
